According to reports in *China Business News*, prices in Jinxiang, China's garlic-growing capital, have seen a fortyfold increase since March. Further down the supply chain, garlic prices have jumped tenfold on wholesale markets in big cities and fourfold nationwide. That compares with a meager doubling in the price of copper this year and a 77% increase in the Shanghai stock market.



Yet, there is some **justification** for the increases. The amount of land set aside for garlic-planting is said to have fallen by half in 2008 in response to low prices. Rumors abound that garlic may prevent swine flu. Cheap herbal remedies are popular in China, and ways to **ward off** disease are compelling in the absence of comprehensive health care.
